

Land Dataset Description

Elevation	3,660-3,680 feet above sea level
Ecoregion	High Plains- The High Plains region, together with the Rolling Plains comprise the southern end of the Great Plains of the central United States. The High Plains is a relatively level high plateau, separated from the Rolling Plains by the Caprock Escarpment.
Soil Type	AcA, FrA, AfA: Acuff loam, 0 to 1 percent slopes, Friona loam, 0 to 1 percent slopes, Amarillo fine sandy loam, 0 to 1 percent slopes.
Air Quality PM 10 Soil Estimate	Low PM10, Very low PM10- These values estimate airborne particulate matter particles in the soil surface less than 10 microns in size (PM10). This metric is designed to identify areas that could emit PM10 particles and to describe the possibility on a scale of 0 (no or very low risk) to 1.00 (highest risk).

Air Quality PM 2.5 Soil Estimate	Low PM2.5- These values estimate airborne patriculate matter particles in the soil surface less than 2.5 microns in size (PM2.5). This metric is designed to identify areas that could emit PM2.5 particles and to describe the possibility on a scale of 0 (no or very low risk) to 1.00 (highest risk).
Mechanical Site Prep Soil Suitability	Well suited- These values estimate suitability for use of surface-altering soil tillage equipment durin site preparation in forested areas.
Pond/Reservoir Soil Suitability	Somewhat limited- Soil best suited to this use have low seepage potential in the upper 60 inches. The seepage potential is determined by the saturated hydraulic conductivity (Ksat) of the soil and the depth to fractured bedrock or other permeable material.
Prescribed Burning Soil Suitability	Somewhat limited- Ratings represent the relative limitations of soil and physiographic factors upon the ability to safely contain the fire, as well as soil and climatic factors on the ability to obtain a favorable vegetative response to the treatment. Additionally, this value assesses the risk of water and wind erosion prior to re-establishing adequate watershed cover on the treatment site.
Range Production (Normal Year Ibs/acre/yr)	1,519-1,844 lbs/acre/year- Total range production is the amount of vegetation that can be expected to grow annually in a well managed area that is supporting the potential natural plant community.
Soil Erosion Susceptibility (Factor K)	0.28, 0.24- Values of K range from 0.02 to 0.69. Other factors being equal, the higher the value, the more susceptible the soil is to sheet and rill erosion by water.
Upland Native Herbaceous Plants Soil Suitability	Not limited- These values estimate the suitability as either primary or secondary wildlife habitat through the establishment and maintenance of native herbaceous plants.
Wildlife Food Plot Soil Suitability (2 acres or less)	Somewhat limited- These values estimate soil suitability for planting and cultivating food plots to produce forage for upland wildlife species.
